Students who have been identified as demonstrating the school values will be awarded with a **Thumbs Up TOKEN** for **learning**, **safety**, **respect** or **relationships**.

This token will be recorded by the teacher and when the student reaches 20 tokens, 40 tokens, 60 tokens, 80 tokens and 100 tokens throughout the year, they will receive a certificate and prize on parade. The student's photo is taken and displayed in the school newsletter to show achievement and success.

Each week at parade, the class with the highest attendance (95% or greater) will receive ZAK the Attendance Koala for the week. Each term, the class with the highest attendance will receive an ice block celebration and photo on the JHSS Facebook page.
