This funding will be used to


- Improve Reading Comprehension for all students in Prep to Year 6.
- Ensure 80% or more students in P-1 receive a C or better in English & Mathematics.
- Ensure 80% or more students receive a C or better in Writing.
- Ensure 100% of students in Year 3 and Year 5 achieve National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN.
- Increase the number of students achieving results in the Upper 2 Bands (U2B) for Reading in Year 3 and 5.
- Minimum 25% students in Year 3 and Year 5 achieve results in the U2B in Reading.
- Support improved pedagogical practice in the teaching of numeracy through the school Maths Team.
- Implement local assessments & Cycle of Inquiry to measure student progress on mathematical targets.
- New teacher induction in school programs of (Light Educational Ministries) LEM Phonics, Gympie Maths Alliance & Reading.

Our initiatives include


- Continue to support school Head of Curriculum position.
- Continue to provide pedagogical coaching and feedback model for all teachers and teacher aides.
- Targeted weekly teacher aide professional development sessions in reading comprehension strategies, LEM Phonics, Writing, Maths and School Wide Positive Behaviour Support.
- Continue to support Gympie Maths Alliance cluster mathematics activities and moderation. Extending activities to include interschool teacher network meetings.
- Additional in class support for reading comprehension program & writing program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- LEM Phonic training for new staff - \$3 000
- LEM Phonic refresher for all continuing staff - \$2 000
- Mathematics Alliance HOC contribution - \$7 000
- Mathematics Resourcing - \$5 000
- Purchase of lower school reading resources to support additional enrolment growth - \$5 002
- Employment of additional teacher aide time to support reading comprehension – \$120 000
- Cohort planning release days - \$30 000
